The Church's Regulations Regarding Fast and Abstinence

Fasting and abstinence challenge us to avoid attachments to the "things" of this world.

All between the ages of 18 and 59 are to **fast** on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
All who are 14 and older observe **abstinence** on Ash Wednesday and each Friday of Lent
All others are encouraged to fast and abstain in ways appropriate to their
circumstances.

This obligation prohibits the eating of meat, but not eggs, milk products or condiments
of any kind even though made from animal fat

Fasting means one full meal each day with the other meals not equaling a full meal.
Eating between meals is not allowed, except for water.

Abstinence means that no meat is allowed

If health or ability to work would be seriously affected,
fast and abstinence do not apply.

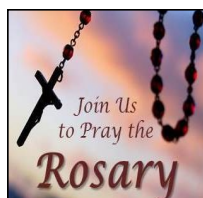
