5. This saint was born in Rome in 540, the son of a Roman senator and administrator. He became Prefect of the city from 573 to 578. After the death of his father he distributed his great wealth and turned the family home into a monastery. In 579 he was sent to Constantinople as the emissary of Pope after being ordained a deacon. While in the court of the emperor, he continued to live a monastic life. He returned to Rome and was named abbot of the monastery of St Andrew. He served as secretary to Pope Pelagius II, whom he succeeded as pope in 590, making him the first monk to become a pope. One of the first things he did was to arrange for penitential processions to the seven churches of Rome in order to pray for the end of the plague, of which Pope Pelagius had died. He was both a contemplative and a man of action. He was the first pope to call himself “Servant of the servants of God.” He sent missionaries to England and he was a peacemaker between nations. He served in the papacy for thirteen years, the last two of which were years of intense physical suffering. The title “the Great” was bestowed on him by Pope Boniface VIII. He is also one of the four Fathers of the Western Church, together with St Ambrose, St Augustine, and St Jerome. Who is he?



## The Jesus Prayer



Christ the Lord and Master of all creation spoke repeatedly of the need we have of remaining in vital contact with God through prayer. He did not speak of prayer as some "occasional" activity, to be practiced once in a while, or five minutes in the morning and night. He commands us to "Pray Always," and He gave as a reason for this: that you may not lose heart and become discouraged. Luke 18:1

The clear implication is that if we do not pray, we will surely become discouraged in the hard battle that life is for all of us. Prayer is not a luxury for the pious or reserved for extraordinary moments; it is a continuing necessity arising from our humanity and needed at every moment of our ordinary existence.

One of the very early Christian methods of prayer was the use of the Jesus Prayer.

This is an adaptation of the humble prayer of the publican who cried out:

"O God, have mercy on me a sinner" Luke 18: 9-14.

The Lord said that this man went from his prayer "justified." The first Christians recognized the power of such a simple prayer as this and adopted it for their own use. Adding to it the Sacred Name of Jesus, they turned it into a prayer of great majesty and power.

The Holy Name of Jesus is the Name above all names, in which we rest our hope and through which we obtain our salvation.

Let us come boldly before God, crying out repeatedly:

**LORD JESUS CHRIST, SON OF GOD, HAVE MERY ON ME A SINNER.**

- Lord I believe, help my unbelief
- My Lord and my God
