Church Remodel

There has been much progress recently, and here are the major updates:

1. The earliest that we planned to be able to begin work was the first week of Easter; however, we are now looking at about a month from then, most likely. We will keep you up to date on this.
2. Once a date has been set for work to begin, we will need many volunteers to assist in moving everything out of the church: pews, office furniture and supplies, etc. Planning for this transition is underway, but please be thinking now about helping: many hands make light work, but we will definitely need many hands! Those with trucks and trailers will be especially needed.
3. At the recommendation of the Building Committee, the church has decided to employ R&R Taylor as our general contractor, and have begun the process of drafting a contract.
4. The estimated cost for the project, due to extraordinarily high labor and material cost increases since last year, will exceed the capital campaign goal of \$1.5 million. This makes everyone's participation in contributing - and fidelity in their pledges - absolutely necessary. However, the Campaign Committee had considered such an eventuality in its strategic planning last year, and we are happy to report that, despite the expensive market conditions in our valley, we will still be able to get the job done. Currently, cost-saving measures are being explored, in order to get the total down as far as possible. Once the final numbers are in, these will be shared with the parish.
5. The City of Belgrade has approved our blueprints, and we are awaiting approval from the Fire Marshall.
6. This Tuesday, April 6th at 7pm, Fr. Gilbaugh will ask the city council members to approve a shared-use agreement that would exempt us from having to add more parking lot area, in return for allowing overflow from the ball fields during our off-hours. Likewise, parishioners would be allowed to park in the ball field lot during Masses, etc. **Please pray that this very important agreement is approved, since we cannot move forward without it!** You are welcome to attend the meeting and speak in favor of the motion if you wish, and space allows.
